**Subject: Decision on appeal against non-accreditation to the UG Civil Engineering program offered by Rajkiya Engineering College Azamgarh, Village-Aikbalpur, Post-Deogaon, Azamgarh – 276 201, Uttar Pradesh.**

Sir,

This has reference to Appeal dated 13-02-2023 filed by **Rajkiya Engineering College Azamgarh, Village-Aikbalpur, Post-Deogaon, Azamgarh – 276 201, Uttar Pradesh** against non-accreditation to the UG Civil Engineering program of your Institution communicated vide NBA's letter of even number dated 17-08-2022.

2. The Appeal has been considered in NBA. Representatives of the Institution also presented the case before the Appellate Committee at its meeting held on 02-03-2023. The recommendation of the Appellate Committee has been considered by the Competent Authority in NBA. Based on the decision taken, accreditation status of the program is given in the table below:

3. It may be noted that only students who graduate during the validity period of accreditation, will be deemed to have graduated with an NBA accredited degree.

4. The accreditation status awarded to the program as indicated in the above table does not imply that the accreditation has been granted to **Rajkiya Engineering College Azamgarh, Village-Aikbalpur, Post-Deogaon, Azamgarh – 276 201, Uttar Pradesh** as a whole. As such the Institution should nowhere along with its name including on its letter head etc. write that it is accredited by NBA because it is program accreditation and not Institution accreditation. If such an instance comes to NBA's notice, this will be viewed seriously. Complete name of the program(s) accredited, level of program(s) and the period of validity of accreditation, as well as the Academic Year from which the accreditation is effective should be mentioned unambiguously whenever and wherever it is required to indicate the status of accreditation by NBA.

5. The accreditation status of the above program is subject to change on periodic review, if needed by the NBA. It is desired that the relevant information in respect of accredited program as indicated in the table in paragraph 2, appears on the website and information bulletin of the Institute.

6. The accreditation status awarded to the program as indicated in table in paragraph 2 above is subject to maintenance of the current standards during the period of accreditation. If there are any changes in the status (major changes of faculty strength, organizational structure etc.), the same are required to be communicated to the NBA, with an appropriate explanatory note.
